## OUR PHILOSOPHY

At Temple Dor Dorim Early Childhood Center we believe children develop a world of knowledge through creative play. Play provides children with hands-on experiences that help them grow developmentally, cognitively, emotionally and socially. With play as an integral component of our curriculum, it enables us to create a warm, nurturing environment where children feel safe to



take risks while exploring their world. This type of environment stimulates curiosity and fosters a lifelong love of learning.



Curriculum is integrated so that experiences are connected and learning is meaningful. Through a centers based approach, children are exposed to a language rich environment that encourages the early skills necessary for reading and writing. Along with academic readiness our goal is to instill within children and their families a cultural identity, Jewish morals and values and a sense of belonging to the Jewish community.

## OUR GOAL

Our Early Childhood staff is dedicated to meeting the individual needs of every child while promoting their physical, emotional, social and cognitive growth. Our learning environment cultivates challenges that enable children to achieve their maximum potential. Our staff is able to elicit creativity, imagination and divergent thinking in our children by fostering their independence, building their self-confidence and helping them to develop a positive self image.



## OUR CURRICULUM

Our Early Childhood program meets the highest standards in education. We are a nationally accredited program (National Association for the Education of Young Children) as well as an award-winning state Gold Seal school. Our Kindergarten Readiness Scores are among the highest in the state. Set in a warm and nurturing learning environment, our developmentally appropriate curriculum ensures that children are able to develop

at their own rate when provided with activities that are planned around their unique abilities.





## EARLY CHILDHOOD PROGRAMS AT TEMPLE DOR DORIM

### THE NEST (3-11 MONTHS)

Our infant program focuses on experiences that foster curiosity and discovery. From birth to age three the most rapid form of brain development takes place. Classroom experiences strengthen fine and gross motor development and acquisition of language provided in a warm, nurturing and safe environment. "The Nest" is comprised of two classrooms where children transition between based on individual growth and development.



### TINY TOTS (12-24 MONTHS & WALKING BY SEPTEMBER 1ST)

Toddlers will learn through active exploration, play and interaction with children, teachers and their environment. Emphasis will be placed on acquiring independence, self-confidence, motor and language skills, and a sense of self. ### TODDLERS (2 YEARS BY SEPTEMBER 1ST)

Through dramatic play, hands-on games and activities, children will continue to develop and refine motor and communication skills. Emphasis will be placed on fine and gross motor development, expanding vocabulary, creative expression, cooperation, and self-help skills. At this age level, pre-reading and writing foundations are set.



### NURSERY (3 YEARS BY SEPTEMBER 1ST)

Emphasis at this level will be on providing choices, challenges, and opportunities that promote intellectual, social and emotional growth. Children will learn through problem solving, cause and effect, and math and science concepts through the use of blocks, puzzles, and manipulatives. Pre-reading and writing skills are emphasized through language based activities and hands-on experiences through center-based and small group instruction.

### PRE-KINDERGARTEN / VPK PLUS PROGRAM (4 YEARS BY SEPTEMBER 1ST)

Through an integrated approach, centers and thematic units will connect all areas of the curriculum, build concepts and add meaning to real life experiences. Reading and writing become an integral part of the classroom. Focus will be on academic readiness skills and active participation in the classroom and school community. Emphasis is placed on Kindergarten Readiness and is aligned with State Common Core Curriculum.
