Labriah Lee Holt currently serves as AIPAC's National African American Constituency Director and previously as Multi-Region Outreach & Engagement Director. In this capacity, she coordinates AIPAC's outreach program to minority leaders across the country, including the promotion of pro-Israel citizen advocacy, AIPAC events, and AIEF missions. She demystifies and ultimately strengthens the US-Israel relationship through ongoing education and coalition building with political, business, religious and community leaders. Labriah began her AIPAC career as AIPAC's Northeast Outreach Director in New York City where she founded the AIPAC Connects program. Labriah was recognized by the New York State Assembly and received a Congressional Proclamation from Congressman Charles Rangel for her outreach work and service within the community. Prior to joining AIPAC, Labriah was a Senior Intellectual Property Associate at Alston & Bird LLP. An Atlanta native, Labriah received her B.S. in Human and Organizational Development with emphasis in leadership and organizational effectiveness from Vanderbilt University and J.D. from Howard University School of Law, where she was a Merit Scholar, Student Ambassador, and Senior Notes and Comments Editor of the Howard Law Journal.
