A Message from Rabbi Bloch

By the time this bulletin goes to print, I will be half way through the month of *sheloshim* (the first 30 days of mourning). As most of you know, my mother, Flo Rita Bloch, passed away August 12th. In some ways it feels like much longer, and in many ways it still feels very surreal. I once learned that, "Grief is the price we pay for Love." And there is so much to this saying - as the experience of grief is so profoundly unexplainable and different for each and every one of us. Loss and love are so unique to each relationship.

As I have slowly been navigating my way through each day since my mom passed, I have been reminded of the preciousness of our Jewish rituals surrounding death - from *kriah* (the tearing of the ribbon), to covering mirrors, to observing *shiva* and reciting Kaddish daily. In fact, Judaism is looked to by all faiths as a tradition that really structures the grieving process, giving us multiple ritual stages to mark time. Each stage (*shiva*, *sheloshim*, and *Yahrzeit*) helps us recognize that we should be moving forward in our grief process. If we do not, then we know we should ask for help. Anne Brenner, author of *Mitzvah and Mourning*, quotes Elie Wiesel as saying, "To love and lose and begin over again, takes courage, resiliency and the help of God." And it truly does take all three.

Thank you for your kindness as I and my family walk this path. Obviously being a mourner will impact my High Holy Day experience, however I do look forward to sharing a meaning-filled High Holy Day season with you.

As the CEO of the National Council of Jewish Women (NCJW), Sheila Katz leads an organization of more than 200,000 advocates who make change happen at the local, state and national levels.

Under Sheila's leadership, NCJW has responded to threats to abortion access, voting rights, childcare access, equal pay, and other issues of equity through protest, advocacy and new campaigns making it clear where Jewish women and allies stand on the most important issues of the day. Sheila spearheaded the creation of 73Forward, a Jewish movement for abortion justice, and the launch of "Rabbis for Repro," a network of more than 1,700 Jewish clergy teaching and preaching about reproductive justice and Judaism.

Katz said her group would launch briefings for Jewish organizations on the ramifications of assisting women seeking an abortion, state by state.

"We can't provide legal advice to organizations, but we can recommend that organizations seek out legal advice, particularly if they are in states where abortion has been overturned," she said, referring to a number of states that have enacted "trigger" bans on abortion to go into effect once the Supreme Court overturned *Roe v. Wade*. "In some of these states, there's legal ramifications for trying to help somebody have an abortion and everybody should know what that looks like in their states and how they're impacted."

We all have a responsibility to report and respond to antisemitism or hate when we see it.

### What should I report?

You should report any incident you perceive as antisemitic, biased or hateful.

Here are some examples:

- Antisemitic or other hateful graffiti in public places, including synagogues and schools.
- Vandalism of religious artifacts such as mezuzahs or menorahs and holy places.
- Online harassment, including hateful social media posts and emails. Remember to take a screenshot!
- Verbal harassment, including emails and voicemails.
- Media-based incidents, including antisemitic or hateful content in a news story.
- White supremacist propaganda.
