# Israel Solidarity Message

#### The Abraham Accords

It's been two years of "firsts" since the Abraham Accords were signed.





But perhaps the most moving of firsts happened on September 15, 2022.

On an official visit to Israel commemorating the second anniversary of the accords, UAE Foreign Minister Sheikh Abdullah bin Zayed Al Nahyan toured Yad Vashem and laid a wreath in its Hall of Remembrance.



"I am here today to remind ourselves of the lessons that history teaches us and the great responsibility upon us to act with tolerance for building our community and society," he wrote in the guestbook.

It was a powerful moment, and another manifestation of how the Abraham Accords – made possible through a strong U.S.-Israel relationship – have reshaped the Middle East.

#### BE SURE TO REGISTER TO VOTE!!

ARE YOU A REGISTERED VOTER? Are all members of your family registered? Your high school and college students who will be 18 by November 8? You can vote in the coming election if you are registered by October 11. Deadline for absentee ballot requests is October 29. General Election is November 8, 2022.

In the past, many more Jews have voted and have influenced elections and the passage of important legislation favoring domestic and international issues. Your one vote IS important!

Here's what we must do: Be sure that all members of our families are registered. Students attending college and children away from home should be registered in their primary residence and vote by absentee ballot.

If you have moved, changed your name, or reached the age of 18 since the last election, you must register by October 11 in order to vote in the November election. If you are not sure whether or not you are registered, go to <u>browardvotes.gov</u> or call 954-357-7050. Registration may also be done in person at your local township office or village hall.

If you have special circumstances that prevent you from registering or if you need more information, please contact me and I will try to help you.

Urge everyone you know to be registered and to vote! As Rabbi Bloch said at Rosh HaShanah, one small act CAN make a difference.



We all have a responsibility to report and respond to antisemitism or hate when we see it.

TO REPORT AN ANTISEMITIC OR HATE INCIDENT, VISIT:

IF YOU FEAR FOR YOUR SAFETY OR THE SAFETY OF OTHERS, CALL 9-1-1 IMMEDIATELY.

# What should I report?

You should report any incident you perceive as antisemitic, biased or hateful.

#### Here are some examples:

- Antisemitic or other hateful graffiti in public places, including synagogues and schools.
- Vandalism of religious artifacts such as mezuzahs or menorahs and holy places.
- Online harassment, including hateful social media posts and emails. Remember to take a screenshot!
- Verbal harassment, including emails and voicemails.
- Media-based incidents, including antisemitic or hateful content in a news story.
- White supremacist propaganda.
