As I am getting through my first month at Temple Dor Dorim and the High Holy Day season, I am so grateful to have met so many wonderful and welcoming congregants.

We really live up to our great reputation. I not only enjoyed meeting so many of you, but your openness and honesty of what we need to work on to make our Temple even better was appreciated. I hope you noticed how much work has gone into cleaning the Temple and improving security. I am sure you saw the number of security guards protecting us and our children. Thank you all for bearing with us as we checked names and IDs coming in the Temple. We are happy to say everything seemed to go smoothly without any issues. We have established security protocols for the High Holy Days and are working on other ways to improve our security all around the Temple.

We are also working on many improvement projects which include:

- New Roofing
- Cleaning and repairing the parking lot and signage
- Preparing regular building cleaning, maintenance checks and projects to lessen large problems later
- Security upgrades
- Computer and phone upgrades - (We were struck by lightning and our phones and computers from 2007 were not running for 5 days.)
- Landscaping need to meet City of Weston rules - (We have had to spend over \$100,000 so far and are only halfway there.)

Of course maintaining such a wonderful building in Weston is no easy chore and, not surprisingly, quite expensive.

Our High Holy Day Campaign, *Beiteinu*, has started off quite well with our raising half of what we need for our goal. I highly encourage anyone that is in a position to give a little more money, or can give anything at all, please consider doing so. The only gift too small is if you do not give anything at all. Even small amounts can have great impact when a community comes together. We really need your support to help ensure we remain the warm, welcoming, safe and clean Temple that all can visit to celebrate lifecycle events.

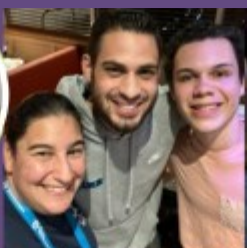

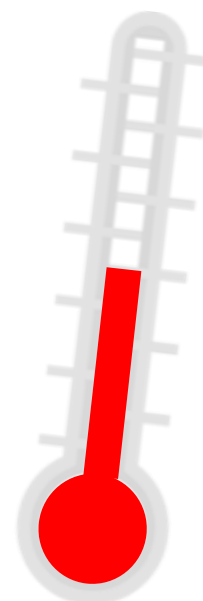


## OUR HOME

We all have a responsibility to report and respond to antisemitism or hate when we see it.

### What should I report?

You should report any incident you perceive as antisemitic, biased or hateful.

- Antisemitic or other hateful graffiti in public places, including synagogues and schools.
- Vandalism of religious artifacts such as mezuzahs or menorahs and holy places.
- Online harassment, including hateful social media posts and emails. Remember to take a screenshot!
- Verbal harassment, including emails and voicemails.
- Media-based incidents, including antisemitic or hateful content in a news story.
- White supremacist propaganda.
