A Message from Rabbi Bloch

Dear TDD,

There is a rare historical photo that has been on my mind a lot lately. It is a picture of a *Chanukiah* (the 9 branched *menorah* that we use on *Chanukah*) in a window that was taken on the 8th night of *Chanukah* in Kiel, Germany in 1931.

It's no surprise that this *menorah* is in the window. Jewish tradition teaches us in the *Talmud* the concept of *persumei nisa* or to publicize the miracle of *Chanukah* by putting our *menorahs* in the window. We are to do this to remind us of our history- that a small army, the Maccabees triumphed over the Greeks in the second century before the Common Era.

However, this photo, taken in Germany, is quite different because it's not only about the *Talmudic* dictum to advertise the miracle. It's about much more. If one looks very closely, on the other side of the street, there is a Nazi flag hanging. The picture was taken from the home of Rabbi Akiva Boruch Posner and his wife Rachel. It was taken to memorialize their defiance. In fact, on the back of the *menorah* Rachel wrote "Death to *Judah* (Jews)," so the flag says, *Judah* (Jews) will live forever, so the light answers."

Every time I have seen this picture it reminds me of the strength and resilience our people had during one of the darkest moments in our history. It also makes me think of all the courageous acts we Jews have performed throughout time.

The last few months have been frightening for us. We have seen celebrities like singer Kanye West and NBA basketball player Kyrie Irving spewing anti-Semitic words and inflammatory statements on social media. And there have been anti-Semitic incidents on the streets of LA, to the boroughs of New York. And "credible information of a broad threat" to synagogues in New Jersey and New York. And we have seen right here in the Weston Hills Country Club public displays of anti-Semitism and racism. And that's not to mention what's happening almost daily at high schools and on college campuses where Jewish students are being accosted.

Antisemitism has increased in our country and, in particular, we have seen a rise right here in South Florida. This picture of the *menorah* in Germany reminds me that we need to continue to proudly show our Judaism; and not only during *Chanukah*, but all the time. We need to continue to tell the world that we are still here and will continue to be.

I ask you as we prepare for *Chanukah*....how will you help to tell others about Judaism? How will you "publicize the miracle" of who we are in your own way? How will you scream out to the world - We Are Still Here!

Chanukah is about bringing our individual light to the world, but it is also about our communal light. Let us publicize not only our *menorahs*....but ourselves and tell the world we are still here.

HAPPY CHANUKAH FROM THE TEMPLE DOR DORIM LEGACY SOCIETY

This year, 2022, Chanukah is from December 18 to 26. We will celebrate the Festival of Lights by lighting the *menorah*, eating yummy *latkes*, singing songs and giving presents. Another custom for Chanukah is to play the *dreidel* game. You remember, you spin it and it lands on one of four sides: *Nun* (נ), *Gimmel* (ג), *Hay* (ה) or *Shin* (ש). Depending on how the dreidel lands, players receive or give back all or some of their Chanukah *gelt*.

Dreidel is a harmless gambling game, but it teaches us all a lesson. You would never want to play *dreidel* with your savings account. The laws of chance tell us that, eventually, you are likely to lose some or all of your *gelt*. We certainly would not want to play *dreidel* with the Temple's money.

Even if we're not playing *dreidel*, the laws of chance also tell us that sometimes bad things, like COVID, happen. When they do, it is nice to have a reserve fund that you can draw on until things recover.

That's where the Temple Dor Dorim Legacy Society comes in. We are building an endowment fund for the Temple just for such an occasion. Our members have pledged to remember Dor Dorim in their wills, estate plans, insurance policies or IRA's, so that in years to come, we will have that cushion. In the meantime, some of the annual income from that fund can help pay the Temple's expenses, provide scholarships, provide dues assistance and many other things.

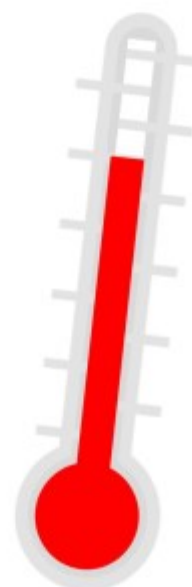

What should I report?

You should report any incident you perceive as antisemitic, biased or hateful.

Here are some examples:

- Antisemitic or other hateful graffiti in public places, including synagogues and schools.
- Vandalism of religious artifacts such as mezuzahs or menorahs and holy places.
- Online harassment, including hateful social media posts and emails. Remember to take a screenshot!
- Verbal harassment, including emails and voicemails.
- Media-based incidents, including antisemitic or hateful content in a news story.
- White supremacist propaganda.
