A Message from Rabbi Bloch

Dear TDD,

The third Monday of every January is officially known as Martin Luther King Day. Most of us know this. Most people also know that King stood for freedom and believed that all people should be treated equally. King's historic 1963 "I Have a Dream" speech is taught in just about every school in the U.S. Many people can even quote verses of it by heart. There was another man, a Jew, who spoke right before Martin Luther King in 1963 in Washington. Many people have not heard of him. His name was Rabbi, Dr. Joachim Prinz. Dr. Prinz devoted much of his life to the Civil rights movement. He understood what it meant to fight for a people – as he fought for his own during Hitler's rule.

Right before Martin Luther King delivered his famous "I Have a Dream" speech, Prinz stated in his address:

*When I was the rabbi of the Jewish community in Berlin under the Hitler regime, I learned many things. The most important thing that I learned under those tragic circumstances was that bigotry and hatred are not the most urgent problem. **The most urgent, the most disgraceful, the most shameful and the most tragic problem is silence.***

Joachim Prinz was not the only person to believe that silence was the most tragic problem. Elie Weisel, world renowned writer, professor, and Holocaust Survivor claimed something similar and said, "I swore never to be silent whenever and wherever human beings endure suffering and humiliation."

As we commemorate International Holocaust Remembrance Day this month, I hope that we are all reminded that as human beings it is our duty to not stay silent – for our people or any people that are threatened due to bigotry and hatred. As we learn in the Torah, all of us were created *B'tzelem Elohim*, in the image of God.

With the onset of the Secular New Year, let us all make an important resolution. Let us challenge ourselves to not keep silent. Help us to not stand idly by while our brothers and sisters are suffering. May we stand up for the downtrodden, the sick, the poor, the hungry and anyone in our world that longs to be free. May we know that we are all children of G-d.

Please join us on January 18, 2023 to commemorate International Holocaust Remembrance Day this month with a special presentation on The Auschwitz Album. Visit dordorim.org/remember for more information or to register.

Shortly we will have a newly paved driveway repainted with reflective lights. We have a new roof and power washed the building removing iron stains from the driveway, sidewalk and building. Hallways in are freshly painted, ECC carpets and floors have been newly cleaned and waxed, and we are reviewing a number of new security measures to ensure all our safety. Stay tuned for more.

We enter the year with great optimism. Our Temple Dor Dorim family is stronger than it has been in years. With membership up, ECC classrooms full, Sisterhood, Empty Nester, and Israel Solidarity events extremely well attended, everything really is looking up. 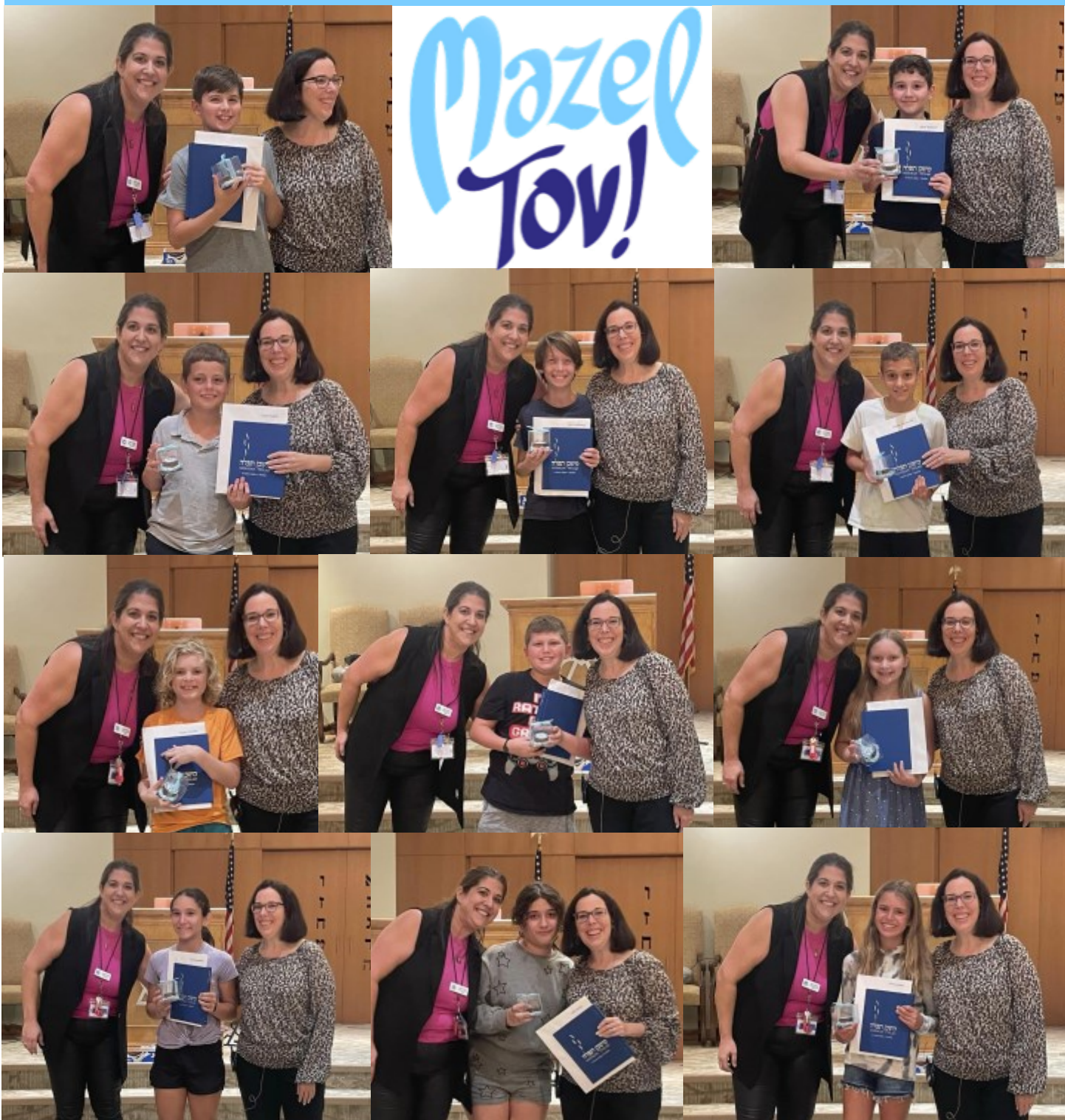

I am reminded of a story that I heard on the late news broadcast just a few days ago. It involved a woman who was flying back to the U.S. from Asia. She happened to be placed in a seat next to a young girl, perhaps age 11. No one else was with her. She spoke some English and the woman found out that her parents had placed her on the plane, by herself, to go to America where she had cousins that were willing to take her in. Her parents wanted her to have a better life.

At the end of the journey the woman said goodbye to the young girl. Her relatives were waiting for her at the airport. She handed her an envelope on which she had written "I hope that you have a wonderful life in America." The envelope was not signed. Inside the envelope was a \$100 bill.

The little girl never forgot that woman, but many years later, with the help of social media, they found each other again. The little girl was now grown up and had started a family of her own. She told the woman that when she got to the home of her relatives, she found they were in deep financial difficulty. The husband had lost his job and they had exhausted their savings. They were going to apply for welfare. The \$100 bill in the envelope was enough to buy the family food for a month. By that time, the husband had found a new job and was able to again provide for them. The little girl had gone to school and then to college, and became an educator. All due to that one small act of kindness.

We often never know what may occur when we say or do a kindness for another person. One gesture may have life altering consequences. 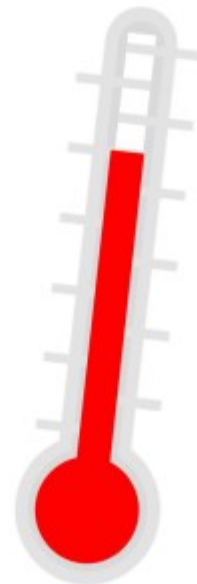
