A Message from Rabbi Bloch

Dear TDD,

It was the "Birthday of the Trees." That's what I remember learning when I was little about the holiday of *Tu B'Shevat* - also known as the 15th of the Hebrew month of Shevat. It was a fun holiday -- a celebratory day for children. We sang Debbie Friedman's famous song "Trees are Blowing in

the Wind" and learned about the connection of trees to the land of Israel.

If you ask many Jewish adults today, either they never have heard of this holiday, don't remember it, or somehow still associate it as a holiday for children. And it's not uncommon that we teach our Jewish holidays and rituals on a child-like level, but usually when we become older we learn the holidays in a more adult fashion. What is it about the holiday of *Tu B'Shevat* that still leaves us thinking it's a children's holiday when, in actuality, there is a great deal of depth to it.

It actually has its origins in the Mishnah as one of the four new years in the Jewish calendar and later became observed during the Middle Ages with a seder honoring the seven species of Israel. Today, for many, it has become known as an ecological awareness day.

Lately, I have been thinking a lot about a prayer that one of the most famous Chassidic Rabbis, Rabbi Nachman of Braslov, wrote. It was about being able to go outside each day, stand among the trees and grass and all growing things and enter into prayer. It wasn't about praying with a minyan. It wasn't about praying in the sanctuary with a prayerbook. It was about praying alone and asking for the powers of the earth to lift us and to energize our prayers. This form of praying was called hitbodedut (seclusion) and it was urged as daily practice to talk openly with God.

Talking to God for many sounds scary let alone outside in the trees. But I dare you to try it. I dare you to begin a practice of getting closer to God. For some of us, we don't know what that would mean. So, like Rabbi Nachman of Braslov, I'll ask you to go outside alone and take in the gifts of God's creations that are all around us. Look at the sky, smell a flower, listen to the birds, or feel the wind on your face and just say thank you. And if you need something to say to get you started praying, here's Rav Nachman's prayer:

Grant me the ability to be alone;

may it be my custom to go outdoors each day among the trees and grass – among all growing things

and there may I be alone, and enter into prayer

May I express everything in my heart, and may all the foliage of the field – all grasses, trees, and plants – awake at my coming, to send the powers of their life into my prayer so that my prayer is made whole through the life and spirit of all growing things, which are made as one May I then pour out the prayers of my heart before the universe like water May I lift up my hands in reverence, on my behalf, and that of all living beings.


- Stand Tall and Proud

My door is always open to hear new ideas on how I can help you experience Temple Dor Dorim in your own special way.



TDD MAKES AN IMPACT


Temple Dor Dorim:






