

A Message from Rabbi Bloch

Dear TDD,

Lately my girls have been singing at the top of their lungs around our home *Mi Shenichas Adar*. I always know when *Rosh Chodesh Adar*, the new month of *Adar*, is about to arrive because they belt out these words with love and joy.

Mi Shenichas Adar translates to "when Adar enters." In the Talmud, it states that "when Adar comes, we increase our joy." Whether we are happy or sad, according to our tradition, the month of Adar is a time of increased happiness and celebration. It is the month associated with Purim and it is the time in our calendar when we commemorate the salvation of the Jewish people from the wicked Haman found in the Book of Esther.

Interestingly, there is another time in the Jewish calendar that we are told how to feel. When the Hebrew month of Av enters, we are told to decrease our joy. This is the month that correlates with the sorrows of the holiday of $Tisha\ B'Av$, the Ninth Day of Av. The Talmud states: "Just as when Av enters, we decrease joy, thus when Adar enters we increase joy."

It's challenging to think that our tradition demands how we might feel and that at certain times of the year we are to increase our joy and other times we are to decrease our joy. And this might be very hard to think of on an individual level. However, on a communal level, to shout out with joy that we prevailed is pretty powerful. In a way, we are to increase our *simcha*, our joy, as the month of *Adar* enters, to say we are still here. Rabbi Jonathan Sacks refers to this as "therapeutic joy" - a joy to celebrate what we have overcome and what still faces us as people today.

The whole month of *Adar* is a time for merriment, fun, play, joy, eating, and drinking. According to the Talmud, it is considered a month of *mazal*. It is a month of good fortune and *mazal* for the Jewish community. In fact, some people schedule medical procedures and court cases in the hopes that there will be a positive outcome.

As we enter the month of *Adar*, let us embrace the joy and spirit of *Mi Shenichas Adar*. I pray that our hearts are filled like my children's with mirth and gladness. Let us find ways to spread joy to those around us. May this season be a time of increased everything - goodness, giving, and unity.


Thank you to Robin Koota, Rabbi Bloch and Jessica Smiley for all your help putting together what will no doubt be an unforgettable evening.




Temple Dor Dorim:







#### Israel's Response to the Earthquake in Turkey

The small country of Israel sent a combined group of 450 people from the Israel Defense Forces, Magen David Adom and United Hatzalah to Turkey for search, rescue and medical treatment after their devastating earthquake.

It's not surprising that the Israeli medical team treating Turkish earthquake victims in Kahramanmaraş are also treating Syrians. In a phone call with the Tazpit Press Service, Lt.-Col. Dr. Ofer Almog described the reactions of some of the Syrians after learning they were being treated by Israelis.


"One person said that everything he was taught all of his life about Israel was a lie. This was the first time they were meeting Israelis, and we weren't as bad as he thought."

Magen David Adom joined Israel's delegation to Turkey, working side by side with the IDF and successfully rescuing 19 people from collapsed buildings. The official Israeli delegation received a warm welcome home and were greeted by Prime Minister Netanyahu. Felix Lotan, a member of the team, is a world-renowned expert in disaster relief and collapse response. In 2021, Lotan counseled Hatzalah South Florida after the Surfside building collapse. MDA provides not just assistance, but aid at the highest level.






