# A Message from Rabbi Bloch

Dear TDD,

Every year as I prepare for *Pesach*, I always spend time looking through various *Haggadot*. This year, a verse that is one of the main messages of Passover really stood out to me in a different way than years past -

*Ha Lachma Anya. Ha Lachma Anya* translates as the "bread of affliction" and this is found in the story section of the *Haggadah* known as the Maggid.

This part of the *Haggadah* is the invitation to all who are hungry to come and eat. This invitation is not just a symbolic gesture, but a call for inclusivity and compassion. It reminds us that we are all part of a larger community, and that we have the responsibility to care for one another. In today's world, where hunger and poverty are still prevalent, we are reminded of the *mitzvah* to feed the hungry. By opening our doors to those who are hungry, we are not only fulfilling a religious obligation, but also sending a powerful message of hope and unity.

So, this year I ask you to remember what is at the heart of our Passover Seder...and that is to help all those in need. This month, Temple Dor Dorim is joining a community wide effort. We, along with other Broward synagogues, will be collecting various food items monthly and donating them to the Cupboard through Goodman Jewish Family Services.

**The food that is being requested of us this month is:**

**Tuna Fish, Sardines, Mayonnaise and Ketchup\***

*\*Please note they are asking for Kosher food.*

Let us strive to create a world where everyone has access to food, shelter, and basic necessities. In the words of the *Haggadah*, "Let all who are hungry come and eat."

- Trauma Kits that ATID Youth Group assembled were delivered to a local Ukrainian Church by our Social Action Committee. A priest will personally deliver the kits to Ukrainian families in need.
- **Teens participate** in a new pilot program, Survivor Friends through the Orloff Department of Jewish Education and Engagement of the Jewish Federation of Broward County; they will be paired with Holocaust survivors for the year with the goal to make a positive difference in each other's lives
- **Donated** 935 pounds of food to Goodman Jewish Family Services of Broward during the High Holy Days
- **Delivered** the donations collected from Shabbark Shalom to The Broward County Animal Care and Adoption Center
- **Supported** the WECARE Food Pantry at Soref JCC with urgently needed food and supplies to enhance their Thanksgiving meals





We all have a responsibility to report and respond to antisemitism or hate when we see it.

### What should I report?

You should report any incident you perceive as antisemitic, biased or hateful.

Here are some examples:

- Antisemitic or other hateful graffiti in public places, including synagogues and schools.
- Vandalism of religious artifacts such as mezuzahs or menorahs and holy places.
- Online harassment, including hateful social media posts and emails. Remember to take a screenshot!
- Verbal harassment, including emails and voicemails.
- Media-based incidents, including antisemitic or hateful content in a news story.
- White supremacist propaganda.
