A Message from Rabbi Bloch

Dear TDD,

In just a few weeks from now we will celebrate the holiday of Shavuot. This is the holiday that commemorates the giving of the Torah to the Jewish people. It is a time of renewal and celebration and when we recommit ourselves to our faith and our community. It is also a time when we reflect on the values and teachings that are at the heart of our tradition.

On Shavuot, it is traditional to read the Book of Ruth. This biblical narrative is about a Moabite woman, Ruth, who converted to Judaism after marrying an Israelite man. Executive Director's Message

Dear Temple Dor Dorim,

The Gala has come and gone and what a fantastic night it was. Congratulations to Megan Greenwald and Barbara Davis for their leadership co-chairing the event and all the committee members that made the event a huge success. A special thank you to Stephanie Farbman and Mara Mittentag for their leadership and securing the gifts and making this year's silent auction the most profitable in over 13 years with \$20,000. Most importantly we are tallying all the final numbers, which I will report shortly, but it looks like a record amount of money was brought in!!!! This is important as these funds will be used for continuing to keep up our building, provide exciting programs throughout the year, and ensure our ECC stays ahead of all the early childhood centers.

Next month, Temple Membership bills will be going out for 2023/2024. Please look for them in the mail and when you can submit your payment; even partial payment helps us with cash flow. If you have any questions, please contact me to discuss. The costs to maintain the Temple continue to rise, but the Temple dues have stayed the same for the last several years. The security fees went up very slightly this year to help ensure we maintain the high level of protection you have grown to expect of us. As you know, many times we have extra security at events including the Broward Sheriff's Office. We are about to begin adding extra layers of protection on all the school classroom doors to ensure a higher level of safety. We continue to evaluate ways we can make the Temple and ECC more secure. You will be hearing about some of the things we are looking at in the coming months.

Another thing we have begun evaluating is ensuring our building can withstand the high level of rain that has been occurring most recently. There never is an end to all the things that the building needs and all the inspections we now have occurring to ensure your comfort and safety.

Again, if I can help you in any way, my door is open all the time. I remain grateful for the opportunity to continue to help make Temple Dor Dorim the "Best" and most caring Synagogue around.

Temple Dor Dorim's Impacts:

- TDD Supporting JFS The Cupboard with monthly food collections
- TOUCHY, our high school youth group, in collaboration with area congregations, volunteered at Give Kids the World Village in Central Florida
- ATID, our middle school Youth Group, donated gefilte fish and volunteered at the JFS Cupboard food pantry.
- Trauma Kits that ATID Youth Group assembled were delivered to a local Ukrainian Church by our Social Action Committee. A priest will personally deliver the kits to Ukrainian families in need.
- Teens participate in a new pilot program, Survivor Friends through the Orloff Department of Jewish Education and Engagement of the Jewish Federation of Broward County; they will be paired with Holocaust survivors for the year with the goal to make a positive difference in each other's lives
- Donated 935 pounds of food to Goodman Jewish Family Services of Broward during the High Holy Days
- Delivered the donations collected from Shabbark Shalom to The Broward County Animal Care and Adoption Center
- Supported the WECARE Food Pantry at Soref JCC with urgently needed food and supplies to enhance their Thanksgiving meals

Dear Empty Nesters and Friends,

As I sit down to write this, I marvel at how fast this year has gone. It seems like mere minutes ago that I took over as president of the Empty Nesters. It was only yesterday that I sat down to write my first article for the bulletin.

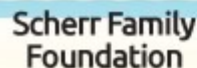

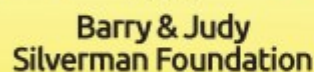

## HOW TO REPORT AN ANTISEMITIC OR BIAS INCIDENT

We all have a responsibility to report and respond to antisemitism or hate when we see it.

TO REPORT AN ANTISEMITIC OR HATE INCIDENT, VISIT:

**IF YOU FEAR FOR YOUR SAFETY OR THE SAFETY OF OTHERS,  
CALL 9-1-1 IMMEDIATELY.**

### What should I report?

You should report any incident you perceive as antisemitic, biased or hateful.

Here are some examples:

- Antisemitic or other hateful graffiti in public places, including synagogues and schools.
- Vandalism of religious artifacts such as mezuzahs or menorahs and holy places.
- Online harassment, including hateful social media posts and emails. Remember to take a screenshot!
- Verbal harassment, including emails and voicemails.
- Media-based incidents, including antisemitic or hateful content in a news story.
- White supremacist propaganda.
