Youth Scholarship Packet

The Youth Scholarship Fund was set up by Tom and Andi Gero in honor of Rabbi Norman and Shoshi Lipson. The Gero's support and contribution, along with additional donations from many supporters of our youth, allow the youth of Temple Dor Dorim to be even more deeply involved in programs locally, throughout the country, and Israel. In this packet you will find all of the information necessary to apply for scholarships. All requests will be processed by the Director of Youth Engagement & Communications and Program Facilitator who will review the application. Scholarships will be awarded on either merit or financial need.

Criteria for Scholarship Fund Applicants - Please read carefully!

- 1) The Youth Scholarship Fund is open to all temple and/or youth group members in good standing. 'Member in good standing' means the following: temple dues are current (if a temple member), youth group dues are current (unless this request is for dues assistance), behavior at all temple, youth group and NFTY events is appropriate, and member displays exemplary character.
- 2) Temple/Youth group member may apply for scholarships in order to participate in various programs including but not limited to TYG (Temple Youth Group) events, regional events, and Israel programs.
- 3) Scholarships awarded for non-temple members may not exceed 50% of the cost of attending the event.
- 4) The Director of Youth Engagement & Communications and Program Facilitator will handle applications and distribution of funds.
- 5) Applications must be turned in to the Director of Youth Engagement & Communications and Program Facilitator no later than 3 weeks before the event deadline and be decided upon no later than 1 week before the event deadline. The early bird deadline will be considered the deadline if one exists.
- 6) Recipients are required to submit a written summary of their experience, including what the program meant to the participant and how it complimented their Jewish education/engagement. This summary may be included in the Temple Dor Dorim Newsletter. In this summary one does not have to mention that they were the recipient of a scholarship, but may if they so choose. The summary must be turned in to the Director of Youth Engagement & Communications and Program Facilitator within 2 weeks of completing the program or event for which the scholarship was given. In lieu of a written summary, and at the discretion of the Director of Youth Engagement & Communications and Program Facilitator and Rabbi, you may choose to make an oral presentation to the congregation.
- 7) If the post-program summary is unfulfilled or not completed in a timely fashion, the recipient *may* be ineligible for future scholarships from the Youth Scholarship Fund for at least 1 year.
- 8) Families and friends of youth group members are encouraged to make donations to this fund.
- 9) All scholarship awards (merit or financial) are confidential. Do not discuss *any* award money with others.
- 10) Exceptions to the preceding rules may be made by the Director of Youth Engagement & Communications and Program Facilitator in consultation with the Rabbi.
