A Message from Rabbi Bloch

Dear TDD,

When I was younger, I remember reading a book called *Conversations with God*. From what I recall, it was written as a dialogue where the author, Neal Walsche, asks God his questions and God answers. It wasn't a Jewish book. But it was a book about a man wanting a relationship with God, a "conversation with God." For many of us, that may not sound very Jewish. We might be asking - who just talks to God? Or maybe we think that God doesn't answer when we speak to God. For many Jews, having a relationship with God is intimidating and scary. Many of us hesitate to talk about God. But actually, talking to God is very Jewish. Rabbi Nachman of Bratslav, who lived from 1772-1810, created a form of prayer called *hitbodedut* translated as seclusion. This prayer involves going into the woods and spontaneously opening one's heart and sharing one's deepest desires aloud. It was a way to build a relationship with God.

If there is ever a time to deepen our connection with God, it's now. It's taught that during this month, the Hebrew month of Elul, that God is closer than the rest of the year. That in some way God is waiting for us to have a "conversation." There is a beautiful story in our tradition about a King. It is taught that the King is inaccessible, and the palace is off limits to all but the elite. Yet that changes when the King travels. As the King passes through the towns and the fields, the locals have the opportunity to engage with this warm and approachable monarch.

Elul is the month when God passes through the town and is looking for a personal relationship. God is looking for us.

I pray that as we move through the rest of the month of Elul and into the month of Tishrei that we know that God is waiting for us. May we all move closer to God in 5784. Let's have some conversations.

I look forward to seeing you all soon and sharing a meaning-filled High Holy Day season with you.

Executive Director's Message

Dear Temple Dor Dorim,

As we enter the month of Elul, the last month in the Jewish yearly cycle before Rosh HaShanah, it is viewed as a month of reflection on the previous year and looking forward to the next year. With this focus, Elul is regarded as a month of *Teshuvah* (forgiveness) or returning to a clean state.

I am sure we all are starting to reflect on our year and what we could have done better. There are many services at Temple from September 9 (Selichot) through October 6 (Simchat Torah).

I wanted to make you all aware of several things happening on our Temple campus. Please notice the freshly painted building, parking lot repaving and cleanliness throughout the building. We also have gone back to mailing out High Holy Day tickets to all members in good standing. They will start to be mailed the week of September 4. Enhancing our security this year, in addition to issuing service tickets, we are also issuing parking passes. The color of your ticket and parking pass represents if you are an Enhanced Temple Member, Temple Member, guest, or staff. When entering the parking lot, the security guard will see the parking pass you display on your dashboard and direct you where to park. If you forget the parking pass, a list of registered members and guests will be checked and directed where to go. If you are not on this list, you will be asked to move to the side as we investigate further.

As we did last year, there will be only one point of entry (Atrium side) into the Temple building and the entire School side will be locked.

We also have instituted a system called SaferWatch. SaferWatch is an innovative way for our Temple and Schools to ensure the safety of all students, staff and congregants. It reduces law enforcement response time and increases the safety of everyone while in our building. SaferWatch provides comprehensive services including a panic button for staff tied directly to law enforcement. Every parent of an ECC, Religious School, and Youth Group student as well as Temple Congregants should download the SaferWatch app on their phone and "join" the Temple Dor Dorim location to be notified of any emergency on our campus, even if you aren't on the campus.

We have also increased the number of security guards and BSO officers who will be on campus during this time.

Let's all be vigilant and aware as we have a safe and sweet New Year.

# A STORY OF TRANSFORMATION WITH ARNO MICHAELIS

Come join us for a real story of *teshuvah* (inner-change) as we hear former Neo-Nazi, Arno Michaelis, speak of his transformation from a racist to a life of peacebuilding.



In the late 1980s and early 1990s, Arno Michaelis was a leader of a worldwide racist skinhead organization, a reverend of a self-declared Racial Holy War, and lead singer of the hate-metal band Centurion, which sold 20,000 CDs by the mid-nineties and is still popular with racists today. Single parenthood, love for his daughter, and the forgiveness shown by people he once hated all helped to turn Arno's life around, bringing him to embrace diversity and practice gratitude for all life. After spending over a decade as a successful information technology entrepreneur, Arno is now a speaker, filmmaker, author of *My Life After Hate*, co-author of *The Gift of Our Wounds*, and an educator working with Serve 2 Unite. Since 2010, Arno has worked in the peacebuilding field in partnership with The Forgiveness Project, Search For Common Ground, and Parents for Peace. He also enjoys spending time with his daughter, art, music, and all forms of fearless creative expression, along with travel, being underwater, and the wonderful natural beauty of our planet Earth.

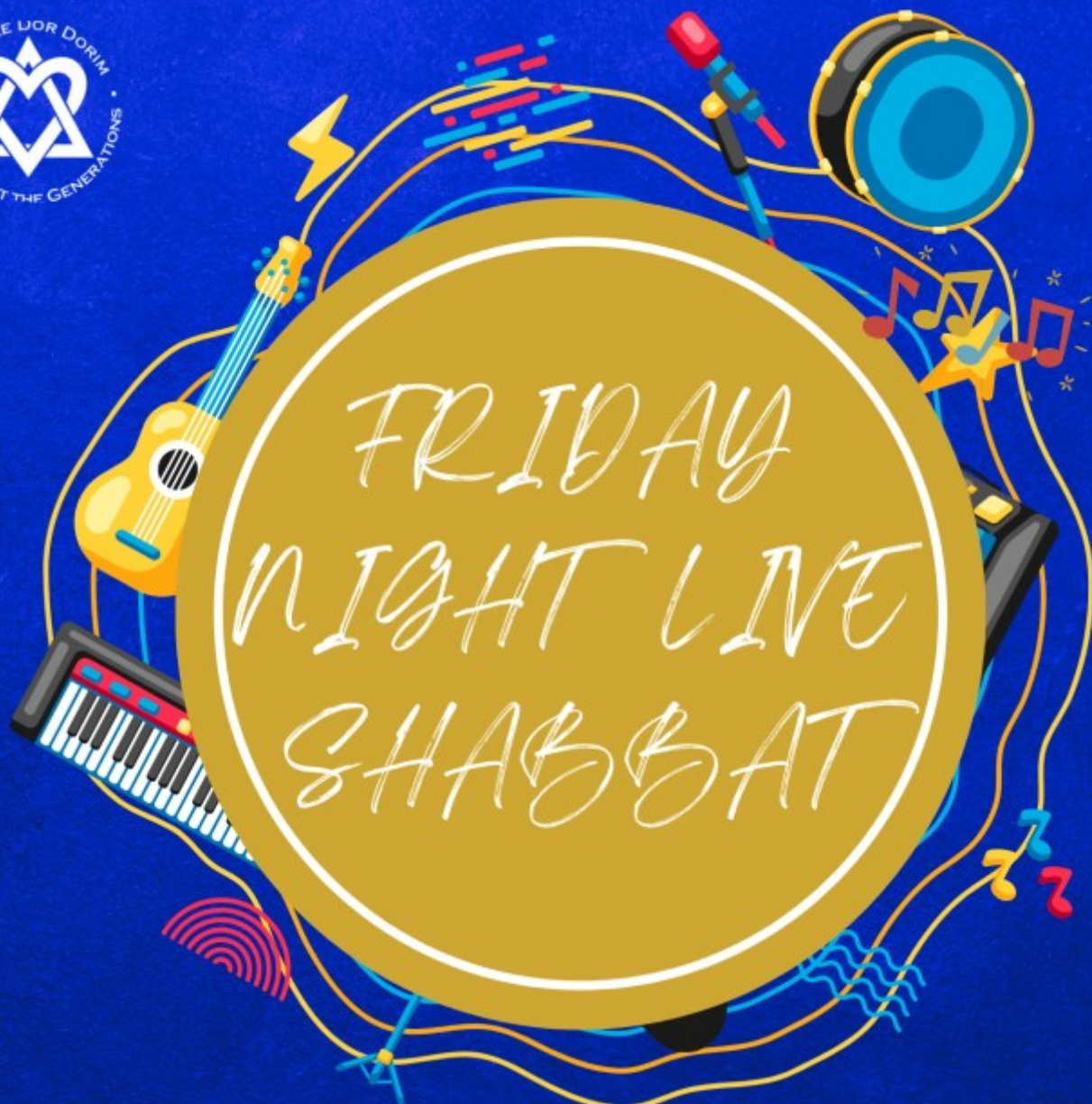

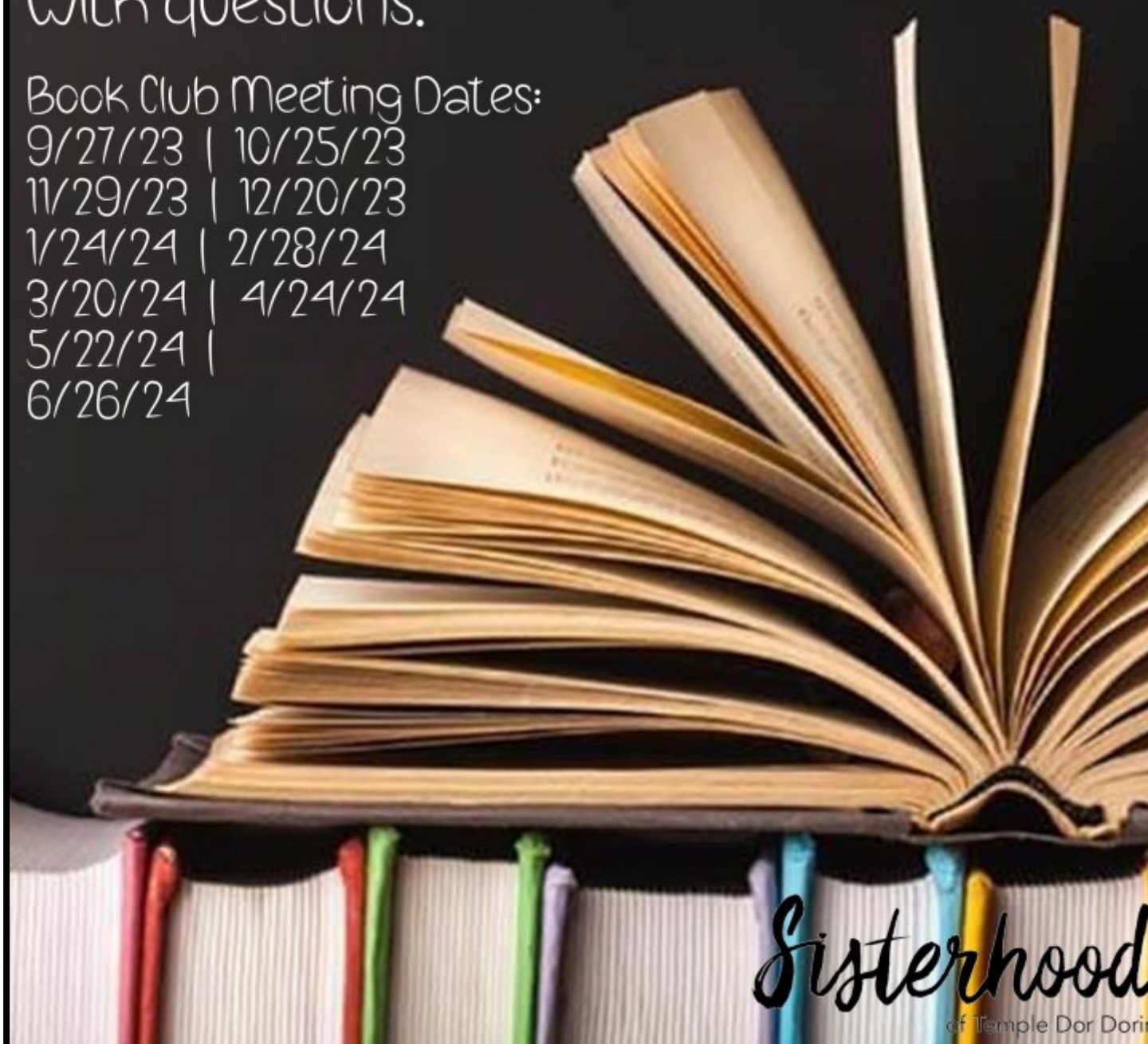

## HOW TO REPORT AN ANTISEMITIC OR BIAS INCIDENT

We all have a responsibility to report and respond to antisemitism or hate when we see it.

CALL 9-1-1 IMMEDIATELY.**

### What should I report?

You should report any incident you perceive as antisemitic, biased or hateful.

Here are some examples:

- Antisemitic or other hateful graffiti in public places, including synagogues and schools.
- Vandalism of religious artifacts such as mezuzahs or menorahs and holy places.
- Online harassment, including hateful social media posts and emails. Remember to take a screenshot!
- Verbal harassment, including emails and voicemails.
- Media-based incidents, including antisemitic or hateful content in a news story.
- White supremacist propaganda.

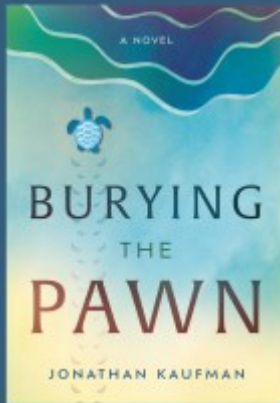

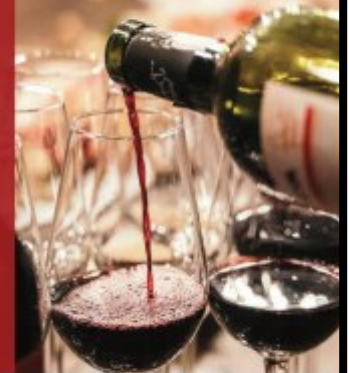
