

A Message from Rabbi Bloch

Dear TDD,

There is an interesting question being talked about more so than I ever remember in Jewish circles. Do we decorate outside for Chanukah this year? (Such as the big bear inflatable holding a dreidel or blue lights.) In the past, this may have been deemed by many as trying to mimic our Christian neighbors. However, this year, with the increase in antisemitism, and all that has happened since October 7, many people want to show the world they are Jewish. Many want to declare with pride that we are resilient.

Jewish tradition teaches us in the Talmud the concept of *persumei nisa* or to publicize the miracle of Chanukah by putting our menorahs in the window. We are to do this to remind us of our history – that a small army, the Maccabees, triumphed over the Greeks in the second century before the common era. We are supposed to tell world we are Jewish, but just a little more subtlety. We are supposed to do it through the light.

So, what do we do? Personally, if there is ever a time to advertise the miracle in the most public way...I say we do it. Put your *menorahs* in the window and, sure, even put out a big inflatable *menorah*. Some of us may be uncomfortable for safety reasons, and I am not saying don't be safe.

In fact, our tradition tells us that if we fear our safety is threatened, put your menorah more inside your home. Yet, if you feel you are in a safe area, let's figure out ways to show the world we are Jewish this year. Maybe you don't want to put a big light-up bear on your lawn...maybe you put an Israeli flag up or tie a blue ribbon on the tree.

In front of our home, we have Israeli flags. It makes all of us feel so good to see them each time we are outside. When the flags fall down due to wind, my girls run to make sure they are standing. They derive so much pride in that we are Jewish, and we stand up for Israel.

I pray for all of us we figure out this year how to shine the light of our *menorahs* out to the world and show the world the Jewish light in our hearts.

Executive Director's Message

Dear Temple Dor Dorim,

Hard to believe it is soon to be the end of the year 2023. I personally can't wait until we turn the page on a new year which always brings such hope. Personally, I very much needed my TDD family this year, and you were all there for me by my side and helped pick me up again. Much has been accomplished this year at the Temple in which we should all be proud. It truly takes a village.

It is hard to be totally happy when so many of our brothers, sisters and family members in Israel are living with the new realities of being at war with people that want to totally wipe us out. We look at our friend's faces all around us in the US and see shock. Numbness. Our hearts are weighed down by constant burden. Over and over again we say to each other: it's a nightmare. A nightmare beyond comparison. No words to describe it. No words to contain it.

Sadly, we know we are only at the beginning of a very long, difficult, and uncertain road. A road that will make new demands of all of us as Jews. Heartbreakingly, it is also a road riddled with the risk of communal rupture and fragmentation – at a time when we so desperately long to come together, to hold one another and to be held in our shared grief, fear, and love.

We still have much to do. We are currently \$21,000 under on our annual campaign. We want to continue to ensure the highest quality of programs and services. If you are in a position at the end of the year to make a donation of any amount, we would greatly appreciate it. This year alone we purchased 6 new AC units and an air exchange system, had to deal with water issues every time it rained hard, and we continued to enhance our security systems just to name a few items which we have been working on. Almost all the mentioned items were not in the budget, but were necessary.

The end of the year is a good time to evaluate priorities and we hope TDD is certainly one of them. There may be possible tax advantages of giving from your IRA or donating appreciated stock or naming TDD as a beneficiary or gifting a membership to TDD for those that cannot afford it. If you have any questions, we ask you to speak to your accountant and then call me to help you execute your gift.

I am continually struck by the enduring wisdom of Anne Frank who said, "Our lives are fashioned by our choices. First, we make our choices. Then our choices make us."





### Chanukah will not be the same this year in the settlements of Southern Israel

We wish all our Temple Dor Dorim Legacy Society members and our TDD family a happy and joyful Chanukah.

Sadly, though, this year, in the south of Israel, there will be no singing, no *dreidels*, no lighting of menorah candles. There will be only quietness, emptiness, on the many *kibbutzim*, towns and villages that were destroyed or evacuated, on October 7. The survivors of the Hamas massacre will go on living. They must.

There are more than 100,000 Israelis who have been displaced from the south by the war. They need places to sleep, to send their children to school, to go back to work, to earn a living. They need daycare centers, recreational facilities, psychological counseling. They are communities in search of a home because they are not sure when, or if, they can ever go back.


