



# **Executive Director's Message**

Dear Temple Dor Dorim,

As the end of the year holiday season unfolds, we find ourselves reflecting on the incredible journey we've embarked upon again this year and are humbled by the unwavering support of individuals like you who have been a beacon of hope for our Temple.

As you all know too well, critical building repairs and maintenance went undone for many years. The Temple is in a very strong financial position; however, we must make significant financial investments in our facility to ensure we continue to flourish. Some of the projects we have identified that we need to invest in our future are:

- Continuing to strengthen our security systems which are now more important than ever before
- Replacing our school playground to ensure we continue to remain competitive and are seen as a leader in education
- Installing appropriate drainage to avoid future flooding
- Other critical building repairs such as replacing air conditioners and landscaping to cure outstanding city violations

These year-end contributions may also be tax-deductible. The tax benefits depend on who you are and what your financial situation might be. One can make a gift of appreciative stock or mutual funds that might provide you with greater tax savings. You pay no capital gains tax on the appreciation, and it still qualifies for an income tax charitable deduction for the full fair market value of the share. People who are over the age of 70 ½ can make direct distributions from their IRA accounts and it will count toward their minimum required annual distribution.

### TDD Family,



# **Legacy Society Message**



### A MESSAGE FROM THE TDD LEGACY SOCIETY

I sat down several times to try to write a Legacy Society message for this month. The only thing that came to my mind were images of the terrible massacre which occurred on October 7 and the 1400 Israeli deaths, men, women and children, and the fate of almost 250 hostages, taken to Gaza. Thousands were wounded.

In Israel, the entire country is in mourning and funerals continue to take place daily. The war against Hamas is entering his fourth week, and thousands of Israelis have been displaced and are refugees in their own country. Missiles continue to rain down from all sides.

It is hard to talk about planning for the future when the future we hope for appears to be so precarious. We know that Israel will prevail, and the country will rebuild, but our sense of safety and security has been, and will be, sorely tested.

I would urge all our Legacy Society members and members of our congregation at Dor Dorim to support Israel in every way possible over the coming months. Donations are needed to help resettle people who have been displaced from their homes. Donations are needed to those organizations who are helping to fight the propaganda battle to combat a worldwide resurgence in antisemitism. That is a battle we must fight as well.

We need to speak to our children, especially those teenagers and college-age, who may be feeling lost and afraid when their classmates single them out for hateful speech because they are Jewish. In schools and on college campuses, we must protest against administrators and faculty, who turn a blind eye to jihadist groups on campus and support persecution of Jewish students.

We need to support the IDF soldiers, men and women, who, though grieving themselves over the loss of friends and family, nevertheless stand up to fight for their country and our country, Israel.


