

#### A Message from Rabbi Bloch

Dear TDD,

Since I was a child, I have always loved Sukkot. I love the connection to the earth and that it's the only *mitzvah* we perform that can completely envelop us. I love that it reminds us that life is fragile and our time in this world is temporary. But one of my favorite teachings about the holiday of Sukkot is that we are reminded of the *mitzvah* of *hachnasat orchim* – welcoming guests. One beautiful tradition that adds depth and meaning to our Sukkot experience is inviting *Ushpizin*, special guests, into our *sukkot* (sukkahs).

The term "Ushpizin" originates from the Aramaic word for guests or visitors. According to Jewish tradition, during each night of Sukkot, we symbolically welcome esteemed guests into our sukkah. These guests include both divine and human figures who have significant historical and spiritual relevance. The divine figures are: Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, Joseph, Moses, Aaron, and David. Thankfully, many practices today also include women such as Sarah, Miriam, Deborah, Hannah, Abigail, Hulda, and Esther.

In addition to the divine guests, we can also invite individuals from our own lives who inspire us and embody traits we admire. These could include: family members (those who are living and those who have passed away but continue to influence our live), role models, and friends and neighbors (those who bring joy, support, and unity to our lives).

Inviting these *Ushpizin* into our *sukkot* not only symbolizes our desire to connect with the divine, but also reflects our commitment to fostering positive relationships and building a sense of community. By welcoming these esteemed guests, we create an atmosphere of hospitality, friendship, and inclusivity.

It is customary to mention the names of the *Ushpizin*. As we do so, we evoke their qualities and strive to embody them throughout the holiday and beyond. Similarly, when we invite human guests, we have the opportunity to share stories, exchange wisdom, and strengthen the bonds that unite us as a community.

As we celebrate Sukkot this year, let us remember the traditional and meaningful practice of inviting *Ushpizin* into our *sukkot*. May our guests inspire us to fill our homes with love and joy throughout this holiday and the entire year.

#### **Executive Director's Message**

Dear Temple Dor Dorim,

As we are in the midst many Jewish holidays, it truly is a mixture of reflection, soul searching and celebration. This time of year makes me think back on my growing up years in Connecticut. All the women for the High Holy Days took their mink stoles out of storage and wore them with a new outfit to Temple. The weather didn't matter, it was a fashion show for sure.

It was great seeing so many of you as you came into the Temple with your families. I hope you noticed the fresh painting on the exterior of the building, the repaved parking lot, and polished the floors; just to name a few things. We still have much to be done on this 25-year-old building.

One of our largest projects is to reduce all the water around the outside of the building including behind the sanctuary which many call Lake Lipson. This has become more important as the rains have become much heavier and more frequent. We must keep the water out of the building which can cause a lot of damage if it gets in. We have hired a civil engineer to do a survey and make recommendations regarding drainage and proper grading of the property. This will be a very expensive and long process, but we have no choice. I have a great team helping me: Mara Mittentag, Peter Shapiro, and Bob Ennis. We are also establishing a five-year capital building budget, so we are not surprised by unplanned building expenses. More details to come.

We were fortunate to win a \$150,000 State of Florida Security Grant. With the grant partnership of Debbie Ring and Jonny Konig, we submitted a grant for a major new security camera system which will be all over the building replacing our older antiquated one. This will be a major upgrade over the next six months.

Much more work is needed on our Temple, our home. Our largest fundraiser every year is the HHD campaign. This year's campaign is called *Shelanu* meaning "ours." The Temple is ours and we must support it and keep it in shape for ourselves to enjoy as much as future generations. We are \$35,000 under our goal right now which we have until the end of this calendar year to achieve. This goal is nowhere near close to the one million dollars it takes annually to keep up the building. So please, as always, give generously to our HHD campaign. If you have given already thank you so much. Quite frankly, we need these funds.

Another positive of keeping up the building is being able to have room rentals when not in use. We have already had room rentals this year, most recently to the Weston Rotary Club for their annual Food and Wine Show. We had over 500 people in our building for this amazing event. The event was so amazing, I even joined the Rotary Club! A special thanks to Jacqueline Gillman who I loved working with on this project and brought it to TDD. We will be looking for other appt rental opportunities and within a few years I hope this becomes a very successful revenue stream for us.

If ever I can do anything for any of you, I am here.






Temple Dor Dorim has run leadership classes each year starting a couple of years after its inception. We have found that strong leadership among our congregants has provided the foundation for our success over the years.




