

A Message from Rabbi Bloch

Dear TDD,

In my last year of Rabbinical school, I remember a classmate sharing in one of our closing sessions that he realized one of the most important lessons he learned in Rabbinical school is that Judaism is all about asking questions. His concluding words were sometimes we may never get answers, but asking the question was what was most important.

As we approach Passover, a time of renewal and reflection, I am reminded of my colleague and his words and the power of asking questions. The act of questioning lies at the heart of the Passover story. In the retelling of the Exodus narrative, we are encouraged to engage in a dialogue that is fueled by curiosity, inquiry and thirst for knowledge. The Four Questions, traditionally recited by the youngest participant at the Seder table, prompts us to explore the meaning and symbolism behind the customs and the rituals of the holiday.

The act of asking questions during Passover is not limited to the Seder table; it extends to all aspects of our lives as we seek to understand our history, our beliefs, and our values. By questioning, we open ourselves up to new perspectives, challenges, and revelations that can lead to personal growth.

This year, our family Seders will lead us to questions that may be new to us in our post October 7 world. I am sure the question of what it means to be truly free as Jews will be a question at our Seder tables. As we navigate our way through our *haggadot*, I ask us all to be gentle with ourselves as the landscape of the Jewish world has changed greatly this past year. I pray that as we close our seder and we say "Next Year in Jerusalem" that we will all say these words with full heart that our Jewish homeland will be restored with peace, love and renewal.



Happy Passover from the Temple Dor Dorim Legacy Society

Passover commemorates the liberation of the Jewish people from enslavement in Egypt, as described in the book of Exodus. At the Seder table, the family will gather to retell the story of Moses and our miraculous deliverance from bondage. We will eat matzah, drink wine and the youngest will ask the traditional four questions.

Except, this year, we may have a few more questions that need answers.

Following the atrocities of October 7, many American Jews were shocked by the waves of hate and antisemitism unleashed in our society. Instead of empathy for the tragedy the Jewish people have suffered, we were faced with hate, intimidation, and violence. Around the world, Jews are being attacked on the streets and have to hide their identity in fear of their safety. As Bari Weiss said in a recent speech called The State of World Jewry, "We are at a hinge moment in history. Our world is changing."

We need to ask ourselves, "What have we done to help to insure the future of Judaism?" We can start by taking steps to protect the future of our own Temple Dor Dorim.



CTS is a research-driven advocacy center that works to end the proliferation antisemitism and all forms of hate and harassment online. Daniel was the second employee of the center after its founding in 2017 and has lead tech company engagement for ADL since that time. Since 2019. Daniel has been the lead author of ADL's annual nationally representative survey of hate, harassment and extremism in online games. He also leads CTS' tech accountability research efforts, such as its Antisemitism and Holocaust Denial Report Card, which look at ways to create research grounded advocacy products to inform the public about the nature of hate and harassment online and to hold tech companies accountable. He has spoken publicly on these issues at the Game Developers Conference, RightsCon, Games for Change and has been consulted on issues related to hate and extremism in gaming by numerous federal US agencies, US legislative offices as well as government agencies in the UK, France and Germany.
